Head Lice Checks

In consultation with Marigold Administration, Marigold PAC has discontinued lice checks in classrooms. This policy is in line with many other schools in the district. Please check your child for head lice at home on a regular basis - ideally once per week!

Please Remember...

- ◆ Head lice are very easily spread through head-to-head contact.
- ◆ Remind your child not to share or borrow personal items such as combs, scarves, brushes, hair-bands, head phones, sleeping bags, pillows, stuffed animals, hats and scarves.
- ◆ If you discover head lice please let the school know so they can notify other student's families. This will help the school stop the spread!!!
- ◆ Students may return to school after treatment is complete.
- ◆ If you have treated your child and head lice is still present, please speak to the Public Health Nurse or Pharmacist before re-treating.

Halloween Safety Tips

There are always lots of safety tips about inspecting Halloween candy, but here are a few about costumes:

- Make or buy costumes in light-coloured material or place strips of reflective tape on the back and front of costumes, so that drivers can better see your child.
- Costumes should fit properly to prevent trips and falls. Avoid items such as oversized shoes, high heels, long dresses and long capes.
- If your child has a mask teach them to lift their mask when walking on the street so they have full visibility.
- Dress your child for the weather. Add layers if needed.
- Put your child's name, address and phone number on his or her costume.
