*It can be hard to stand up for yourself. *Be assertive, not aggressive. *Telling is not tattling. *Fighting back only makes it worse. * Put yourself in other kid's shoes* If you walk away and get help, you are part of the solution; if you stay and watch, you are part of the problem. *Bottom line is respect - the language we use and the way we use it is the most powerful tool!
